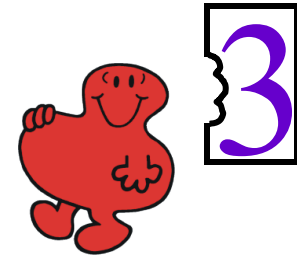


Christmaths with the Mr Men

What are these two numbers?



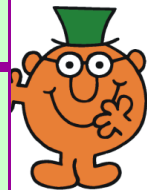
