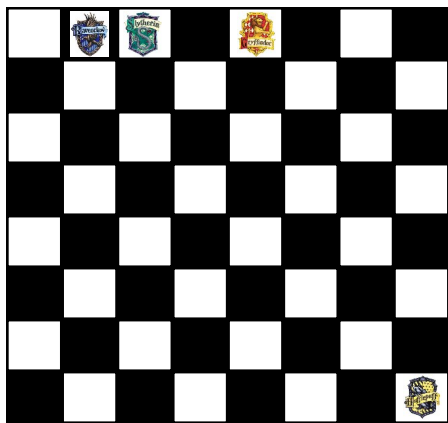
'There are two Philosopher's Stones!' he exclaimed. 'The second one is owned by...'. The pause was quite deliberate. 'Father Christmas!'
